Hindu——<u>Bhagavad-gita Text 50</u> A person engaged in dedicated service through work is detached from both good and bad actions. Strive for yoga, Arjuna. It is the art of all work.

The Dignity of Work

Buddhism——<u>Mahasatipatthana Sutta</u> (On Obstacles to Be Overcome) When laziness is present, the worker knows it. When laziness is not present, the worker knows it. The worker knows how to avoid this and to take pride in the work created with dignity, and calm, and peacefulness.

Islam—Allah says do not take away from people what is their due (Al_A raf_7:85); Woe to those who give less than what the worker is due (Al_Mutaffifin 83:1-3); Do not burden workers beyond their capacity; and, if you do burden them, help them (Al_Bukhari)

Judaeo Christian—Exodus 35:30 to 34 "Moses spoke to the Israelites and said, "The Lord has chosen Bezalel, son of Uri, son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah. The Lord has filled him with a divine spirit of skill and understanding and knowledge in a diversity of crafts. He has mastered embroidery. He can create things of gold, silver, and bronze. He is skilled in cutting and mounting valuable stones and in wood carvings. The Lord has given to him and also to Oholiab, son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan, the great skill to teach others.
